September 13. Travel west to the magnificent **Oregon coast**. We'll stop at the **Tillamook Cheese Factory** then board the **Oregon Coast Scenic Railroad** for an excursion pulled by an historic steam locomotive. After a stop at **Ecola State Park**, we'll stay the night at the **Shilo Inn Suites** in Seaside. (B)

September 14. We'll drive east, seeing the sights of the spectacular **Columbia River Gorge**, and climb through the timbered forests of Mount Hood to the famed **Timberline Lodge**, where we'll spend our first of two nights. (B)

September 15. From the small town of Hood River, we'll board the **Mount Hood Railroad** for a scenic journey through woods, orchards and vineyards, with views of Mount Hood and Mount Adams.



A visit to **The Dalles' Columbia Gorge Discovery Center & Museum** rounds out the day's activities. Second of two nights at the Timberline Lodge. (B, L)

September 16. Travel northwest and stop at the **Mount Saint Helens Visitor Center** at Silver Lake. Later, we'll board the **Chehalis-Centralia Railroad** for a ride on an historic steam train through the river valley. Tonight's lodging will be the first of two nights at the **Hotel RL** in Olympia. (B, L)

September 17. Today we'll board the **Mount Rainier Railroad & Logging Museum's** heritage steam train for a ride through the forest and across the glacier fed river, and explore their collection of logging locomotives. Later, we'll enjoy a **scenic cruise** out of Gig Harbor at the southern end of Puget Sound. After another wonderful day, we celebrate our tour with a farewell dinner. Second of two nights at the Hotel RL. (B, D)

September 18. We'll transfer to the **Seattle Airport** for our flight home following a memorable Ramble! (B)
