*Join us on this customized trip to experience railroading and other historic sites in Michigan and surrounding states. We are fortunate to have **Ronald Bailey**, president of the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania's advisory council, as a co-host on this Ramble.*

**JUNE 14.** Morning departure from the **Lancaster Airport** parking lot on chartered motorcoach. Pick up travelers at **AAA Central Penn Harrisburg** office parking lot. Turnpike lunch stop on your own. Visit to and train ride on the **Lorain & West Virginia Railroad**. Included dinner at the **Berea Union Depot**. Overnight stay at the **Embassy Suites** in Independence, Ohio.

**JUNE 15.** Included breakfast at the hotel. Visit to **Greenfield Village**, with its collection of historic homes, a roundhouse and other buildings, including a ride on a vintage train. Lunch on your own on site. Included dinner this evening at **Wixom Station**. First of two nights' stay in Lansing, Michigan at the **Hampton Inn East**.

**JUNE 16.** Included breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the **Steam Railroading Institute**, home to the Pere Marquette locomotive No. 1225, the inspiration for the *Polar Express* engine. Lunch on your own. Visit to the **Great Lakes Central Railroad** mechanical shops. **Dinner cruise** aboard the *Grand Princess* on the Grand River. Second of two nights' stay in Lansing.

**JUNE 17.** Included breakfast at the hotel. Train ride on the **Charlotte Railroad**. Lunch on your own. Visit to the **Crossroads Village**, with a train ride on the **Huckleberry Railroad**. Visit to the **Michigan Railroad History Museum**, with an included dinner at the **Durand Union Station**. First of three nights' stay in Ann Arbor, Michigan at the **Hampton Inn South**.



**JUNE 18.** Included breakfast at the hotel. Train ride on the **Southern Michigan Railroad**. Included lunch at **Harold's Place**. Train ride on the **Little River Railroad**. **Old Road Dinner & Murder Mystery Train** at Blissfield. Second of three nights' stay in Ann Arbor.
