

# What To Do In The Museum

- ① **ROLLING STOCK HALL:** Experience our world-class collection of locomotives, freight cars, passenger cars and other historic railroad equipment. A number of pieces are open for you to explore. Closes at 5:00 pm.
- ② **STEINMAN STATION:** Enter our 1915-era train station, where you can watch our orientation video, introducing you to railroading in Pennsylvania and to the Museum itself. Last showing at 4:30 pm.
- ③ **STEWART JUNCTION:** Play and learn with the many hands-on and educational activities in our railway education center. Fun for the young and young at heart! Closes at 4:30 pm.
- ④ **TRAIN YARD:** See our historic turntable and various railroad equipment awaiting restoration. Open conditions permitting. Closes at 4:30 pm.
- ⑤ **WHISTLE STOP SHOP:** Choose a keepsake to remember your Museum visit. Our store has wonderful books, toys, DVDs, clothing, railroad art and much more. Closes at 4:45 pm.
- ⑥ **PROGRAMS, TOURS & DEMONSTRATIONS:** Check on the blackboard at the rear of the lobby and with Museum admissions staff for information.
- ⑦ **CAB SIMULATOR:** Take control of the throttle in our authentic Norfolk Southern freight locomotive cab. Closes at 4:45 pm.
- ⑧ **EXHIBIT GALLERY:** View railroad art, artifacts and various changing exhibits. You may also access the Rolling Stock Hall observation bridge. Closes at 4:45 pm.

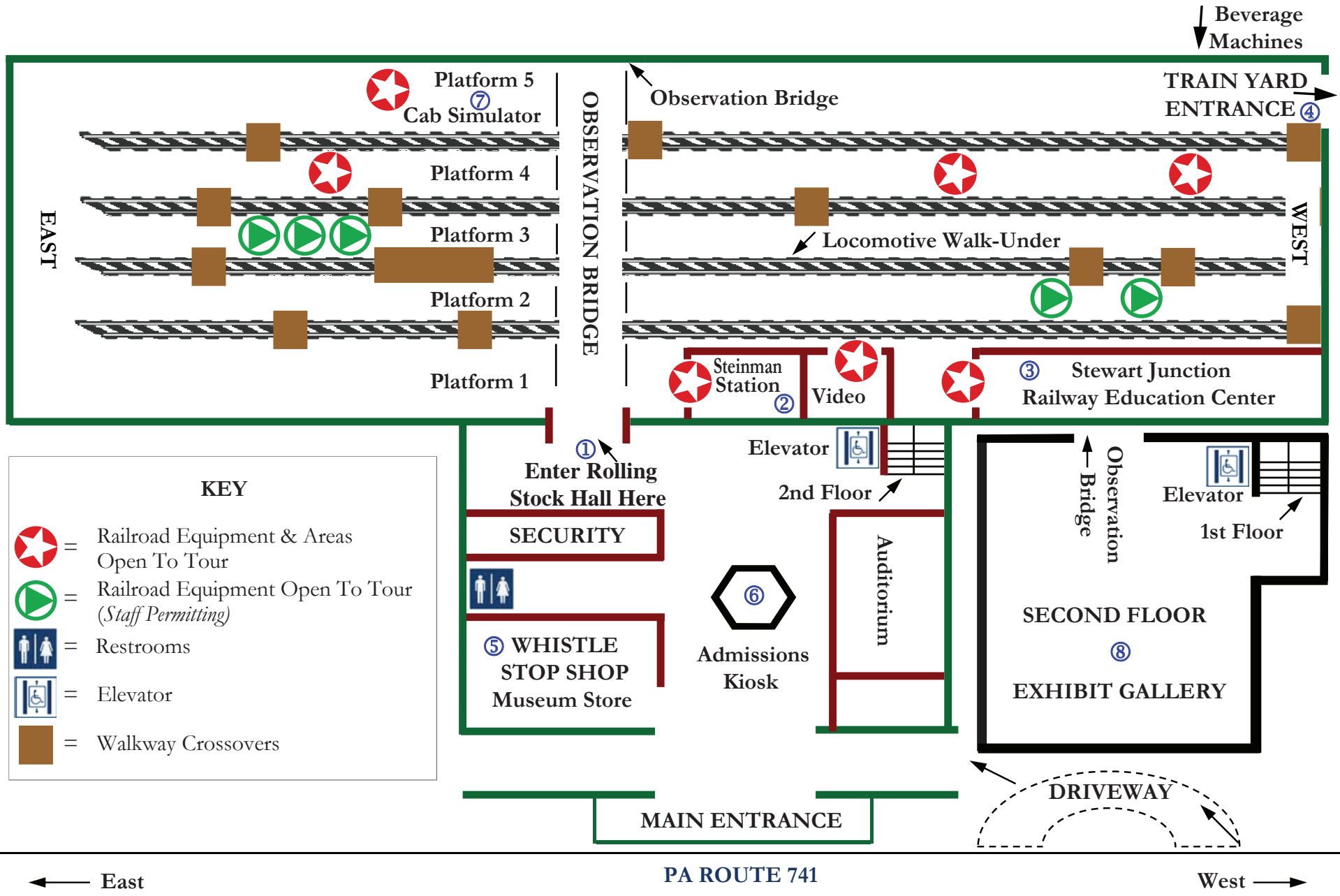
