

Safety First!

As the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania reopens to the public, operations have been adjusted to provide a safer environment for all staff, volunteers, and visitors and to prevent or mitigate the spread of COVID-19. *Therefore, the following guidelines will apply:*

Face Mask Required

All visitors, volunteers, and staff must wear a face mask upon entering and while visiting our museum and grounds. For the safety of everyone, anyone not willing to wear a mask will not be admitted.

Social Distancing Required

All visitors, volunteers, and staff must practice social distancing by remaining 6 feet away from anyone not in your party.

Limiting Capacity

To ensure social distancing and keep our staff, volunteers, and visitors safe, we are reducing capacity at our museum in accordance with Department of Health guidelines.

Hand Hygiene

Visitors should wash their hands or use hand sanitizer frequently during their visit. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the museum.

If You Have Symptoms

Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (including fever, cough, chills, sore throat, fatigue, shortness of breath, or loss of taste) should refrain from visiting until they are symptom-free. We will welcome you back at that time.

Cleaning and Disinfecting

Restrooms and other “high touch” surfaces, including door handles, push plates, railings, switches, countertops, and benches will be cleaned frequently throughout the day.

Additional Information

No large gatherings, group tours, in-person special events, or facility rentals are scheduled at this time.

Virtual programming will continued to be offered at this time, in addition to regular in-person visitation.

Some of our high-touch interactives may be temporarily unavailable, as they are difficult to keep clean and sanitized during periods of heavy visitation.

These changes will give our staff and volunteers the opportunity to readjust to daily operations during this early period of business in the “new normal.”
