

Trains In The Poconos Ramble

Saturday, June 1, 2019



Join the Friends of the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania for this customized, early summer Ramble in the Poconos.

We'll board our chartered motorcoach at 5:00 a.m. at the **LANCASTER AIRPORT** parking lot and make a 6:00 a.m. stop to pick up passengers at the **AAA LEBANON** parking lot. You may bring snacks and beverages on our motorcoach.

Our morning will be spent at **STEAMTOWN NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE** in Scranton, where we'll be greeted by and receive an orientation to the facility from a national park ranger. Steamtown is a railroad museum and heritage railroad at the site of the former Scranton yards of the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western Railroad. The site also features several original outbuildings dated between 1899 and 1902.

A guided turntable demonstration will be followed by a short train ride on the property. A highlight of the visit to Steamtown will be our combined, guided tour of the locomotive shop and the restoration shop. At the end of the tour, there will be limited free time for independent brief visits to the site's history museum, technology museum and museum store.

We'll enjoy an included boxed lunch from **COOPER'S SEAFOOD HOUSE** as we travel on our motorcoach to Honesdale, where we'll have a guided tour of the **WAYNE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY's** railroad themed exhibits.

Next, we'll board the **STOURBRIDGE LINE's** *Glen Eyre Limited* train in Honesdale for a 2½-hour, 25-mile roundtrip ride through the Lackawaxen River Valley. Honesdale was the birthplace of America's commercial railroad, as the *Stourbridge Lion* steam locomotive made its way over three miles of wooden track laid across the river on a 30-foot high trestle bridge in August 1829.

After returning to Honesdale, we'll have an included dinner at **SCARFALLOTO'S TOWNE HOUSE RESTAURANT.**

Finally, we'll board our motorcoach for the return trip to AAA Lebanon and the Lancaster Airport after a memorable day's Ramble.
